Today we are making two important announcements.

Prices changes effective November 1, 2007

To reflect the current reality of the US / CDN dollars exchange rate, and the greater cost of Health Canada licensing and GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices) requirements, the prices for all BioSuperfood and BioPreparation formulas are augmented effective November 1, 2007 as per attachment. In order to obtain and maintain the right to use a NPN (Natural Product Number) granted by Health Canada, Good Manufacturing Practices for natural health products must be employed to ensure product safety and quality. This requires that appropriate standards and practices regarding product manufacture, storage, handling and distribution of natural health products be met. The provisions cover: specifications (product), premises, equipment, personnel, sanitation program, operations, quality assurance, stability, records, sterile products, lot or batch samples, and recall reporting.

Format change for BioSuperfood formulas

In order to maintain Health Canada NPN licensing all new batches of BioSuperfood must reflect the specifications of the granted licenses. The application for licensing started in 2004 had specified a capsule size of 290mg and a bottle quantity of 180 capsules. After a long waiting period, the NPN licenses were granted with these size and format in January 2007. The future batches of bottles must reflect the application granted and thus the bottle will contain 180 capsules instead of 250, and the capsule size will return to the larger size of 290mg in contrast to the current size of 190mg. The new format will contain 52.2 grams of powder in lieu of 47.5 grams currently, for a gain of 4.7 grams, or 25 additional capsules of the current 190mg format.

With this new 290mg size, we suggest to maintain the same frequency of intakes per day while there exist the opportunity to split a capsule in two or three intakes of 100mg or 145mg.

While we are implementing the new format for formula F3 immediately, the stocks of the old format for formulas F1 and F2 will last approximately 5 months. The BioPreparation capsule size and quantity per bottle are not subject to this licensing and thus will not change at this time.
